Catherine Kellett trained in Orthopaedic Surgery in Oxford. Towards the end of her training she spent six months working in trauma and general orthopaedics in Geneva, Switzerland. She then completed 18 months fellowship in lower limb joint reconstruction at Mount Sinai Hospital, Toronto. In 2007, Catherine was appointed as Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon, working for five years in NHS Tayside and the University of Dundee, before joining the Golden Jubilee National Hospital in 2012. Catherine is a specialist primary and revision hip and knee Arthroplasty Surgeon, with interests in arthroplasty research and surgical education.

As a 2011 BOA Travelling Fellow, she was Visiting Professor at the University of Toronto and Research Collaborator at Mayo Clinic. She was an ABC Travelling Fellow in 2012 and is a member of the British Orthopaedic Association Training Standards Committee
