He is a specialist in hip reconstructive arthroplasty surgery particularly young and complex revision surgery. He undertook a fellowship in adult reconstruction of the hip and knee at the Department of lower limb arthroplasty, Vancouver General Hospital. He was awarded the British and American Hip Societies Travelling Fellow in 2005 and the ABC Fellowship in 2008.

His research interests are in the basic science of wear particles and tissue engineering with regard to implant fixation and bone regeneration. He is an active member of the BHS and BORS, link person the BOA for the Southern General teaching hospital and Clinical Director for elective orthopaedics for Greater Glasgow & Clyde. He is the present President of the West of Scotland Orthopaedic Research Society (WoSORS) and orthopaedic lead in the Glasgow Orthopaedic Research Initiative at Glasgow University (GLORI).
