Joe joined the Golden Jubilee National Hospital arthroplasty unit in Glasgow in 2007, where he works as a full time consultant in orthopaedics. There, he has devoted himself exclusively to hip and knee arthroplasty. His main interest is hip revision, and in particular the management of infected hip replacements. He personally provides a periprosthetic hip infection service covering around 30% of the Scottish population.

It was at the Golden Jubilee where he also developed an interest in computer aided knee arthroplasty. He has become a leading figure in this field and participates in training courses, lectures and fellowships. He is proud to be able to provide state of the art arthroplasty surgery for patients within the Scottish National Health Service.

Joe is regularly involved in lecturing to junior and senior colleagues several times a year in knee and hip arthroplasty courses. He has also had the privilege to train many fellows in hip and knee arthroplasty, many of whom have gone on to become successful hip and knee surgeons.
