Sanjeev Patil is a full time Orthopaedic Consultant at Southern General Hospital, Glasgow, Scotland, UK. He completed his higher orthopaedic training from the West of Scotland Training programme, Glasgow, UK. He undertook a fellowship in Adult reconstruction at Vancouver General Hospital, Canada and has been a Travelling fellow at the Mayo clinic, Rochester and Rush Hospital, Chicago. He has undertaken further training in Young adult hip surgery at San Diego, USA; Homburg, Germany; Vail, Colorado, USA and Aarhus, Denmark. He has also been a joint American-British Hip Society Travelling Fellow.

His clinical practice includes all aspects of Hip surgery including conservative hip procedures (Ganz osteotomy, Hip arthroscopy etc), primary and revision hip arthroplasty procedures. He has set up a Tertiary “Young Adult Hip service” at Glasgow.

He is part of a dedicated research team, which is involved, in various research projects in adult hip surgery at Southern General Hospital, Glasgow. He has jointly set up a nationally recognised “Clinical fellowship in Adult Lower Limb Reconstruction”. He remains the joint organiser for “Hip Term” teaching for the West of Scotland Orthopaedic Training Programme.

He remains an Honorary Clinical Tutor for University of Edinburgh, University of Dundee and University of West of Scotland.
